Mentoring relationships help people in their perceptions and experience that there is someone who cares about them, assures them while dealing with day-to-day challenges, and makes them feel like they matter. Research to date shows that mentoring relationships have positive effects on young people in a variety of personal, academic, and professional areas.</p> <p>Brumovská is a researcher from the Czech Republic with a background in applied social sciences. With a Ph.D. in Sociology, she has spent almost two decades studying mentoring for socially-disadvantaged children and young people in general.</p>
